After the introduction of GST, Entry Tax, Luxury Tax & Entertainment Tax were subsumed in GST, except the dealers dealing in 5 Petroleum products i.e. Petrol, Diesel, Aviation Turbine Fuel (ATF), Natural Gas & Alcoholic Liquor for human consumption. (2) Taluka-wise and District-wise bifurcation is not available due to the implementation of Goods & Services Tax Act, 2017.
